

Accepted abstracts will also be included in the **Abstract Book** (official congress material), which will be distributed to all registered participants at the Congress.


During the Congress, the best oral or poster presentations will be awarded by an independent Scientific Award Committee (on the basis of scientific merit of the work presented)

Η παρεντερική χορήγηση σιδήρου θα πρέπει να αποφεύγεται σε ασθενείς με ηπατική δυσλειτουργία στους οποίους οποιαδήποτε υπερφόρτωση με σίδηρο αποτελεί επιβαρυντικό παράγοντα, ιδιαίτερα σε περιπτώσεις Πρωμής Δερματικής Πορφύρας. Συνιστάται προσεκτική παρακολούθηση των επιπέδων σιδήρου για την αποφυγή υπερφόρτωσης με σίδηρο. Ο παρεντερικός χορηγούμενος σίδηρος πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε περίπτωση οξείας ή χρόνιας λοιμώδους ασθένειας, εκζέματος ή σπογγικών αλλεργιών. Συνιστάται η διακοπή της χορήγησης του FERINJECT σε ασθενείς με σιδηροχρόμη βακτηριαιμία. Σε ασθενείς με χρόνια λοιμώδη πρέπει να διενεργηθεί αξιολόγηση της σχέσης κινδύνου/οφέλους, λαμβάνοντας υπόψη την καταστολή της ερυθροποίησης. Θα πρέπει να γίνεται προσοχή για την αποφυγή πεμφφελικής εξεργείωσης κατά τη χορήγηση του FERINJECT. Η περιφερική εξεργείωση του FERINJECT στο σημείο της ένεσης μπορεί να οδηγήσει σε καστανό δυσκοιματόμακτο και ερεθισμό του δέρματος. Σε περίπτωση πεμφφελικής εξεργείωσης, η χορήγηση του FERINJECT πρέπει να διακοπεί αμέσως. Ένα ml μη-ορασιμμένου FERINJECT περιέχει μέχρι 0,24 mmol (5,5 mg) νατρίου.
